



Zoom - Audio Set Up

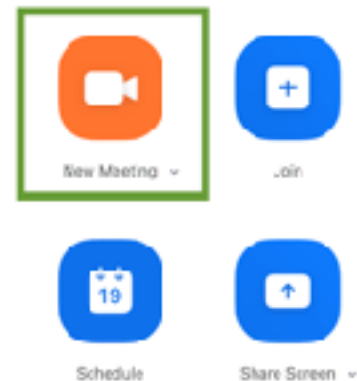
To get the best experience out of a virtual lesson you should set up Zoom before the start of your lesson. We recommend using a laptop as tablets and phones don't allow for the same audio setup so the audio quality won't be as good.

If you are using a laptop:

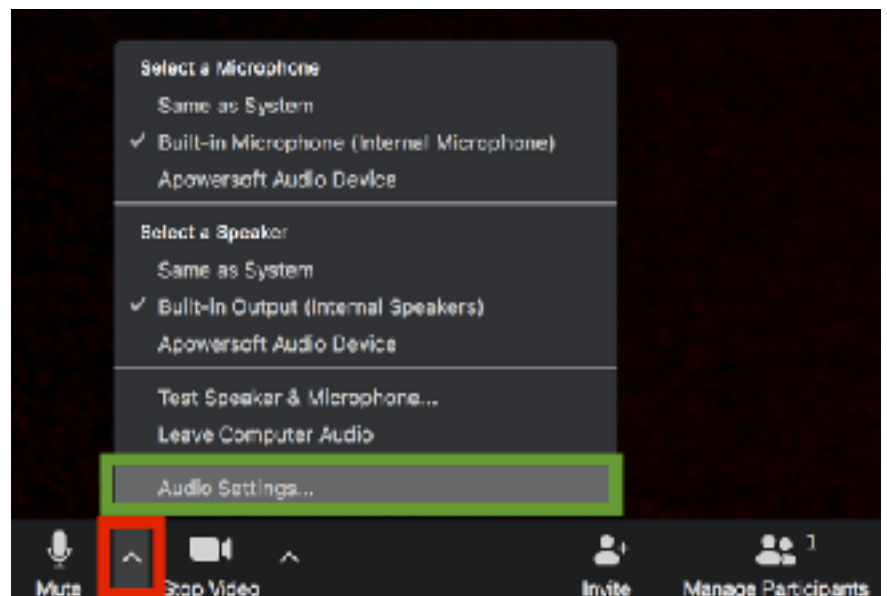
Download Zoom for free from: <https://zoom.us/download>

If you already have Zoom installed please make sure you are using the latest version.

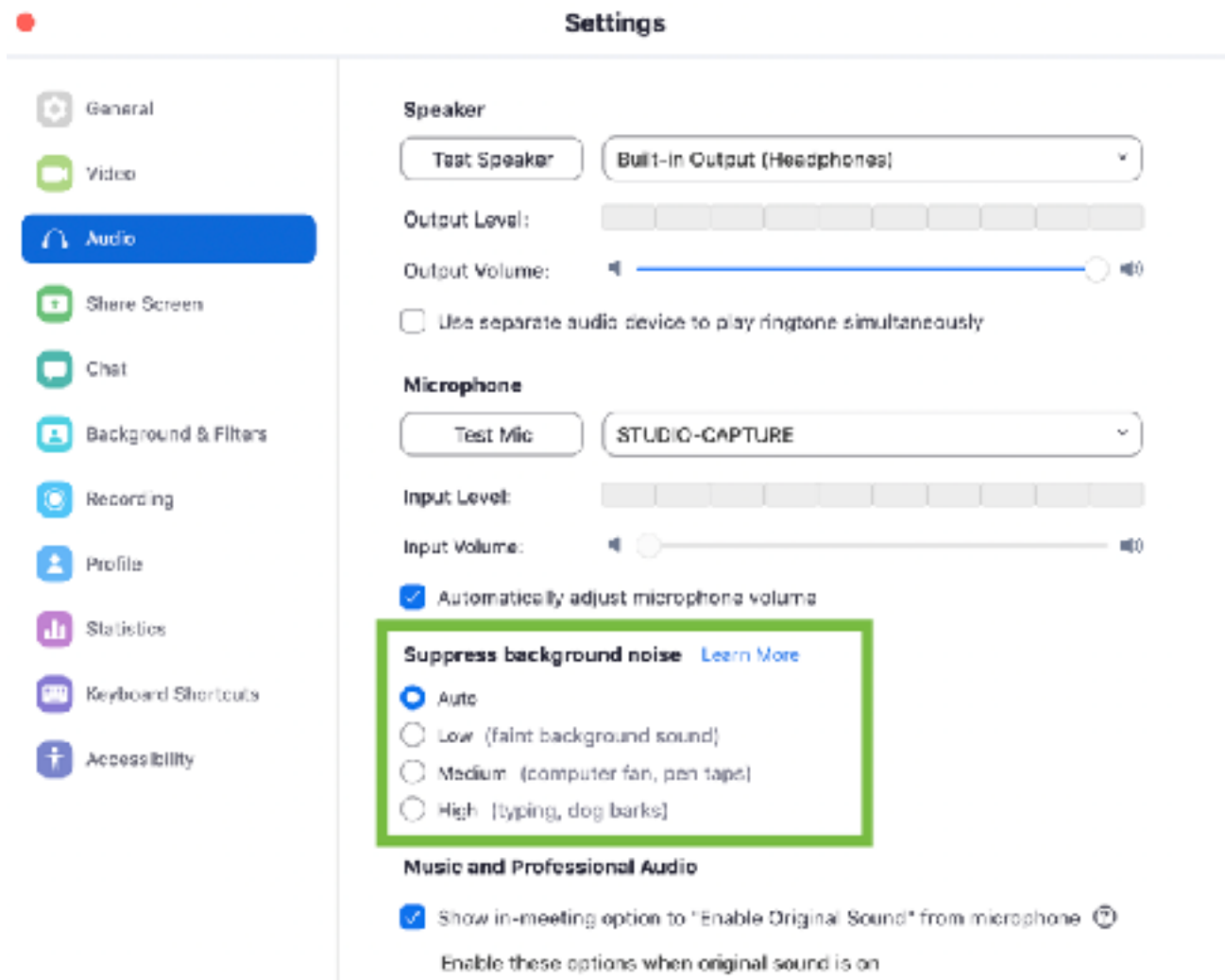
Start a meeting by clicking on New Meeting:



In the bottom left corner click on the little up arrow next to the 'Mute' button and then 'Audio settings'.

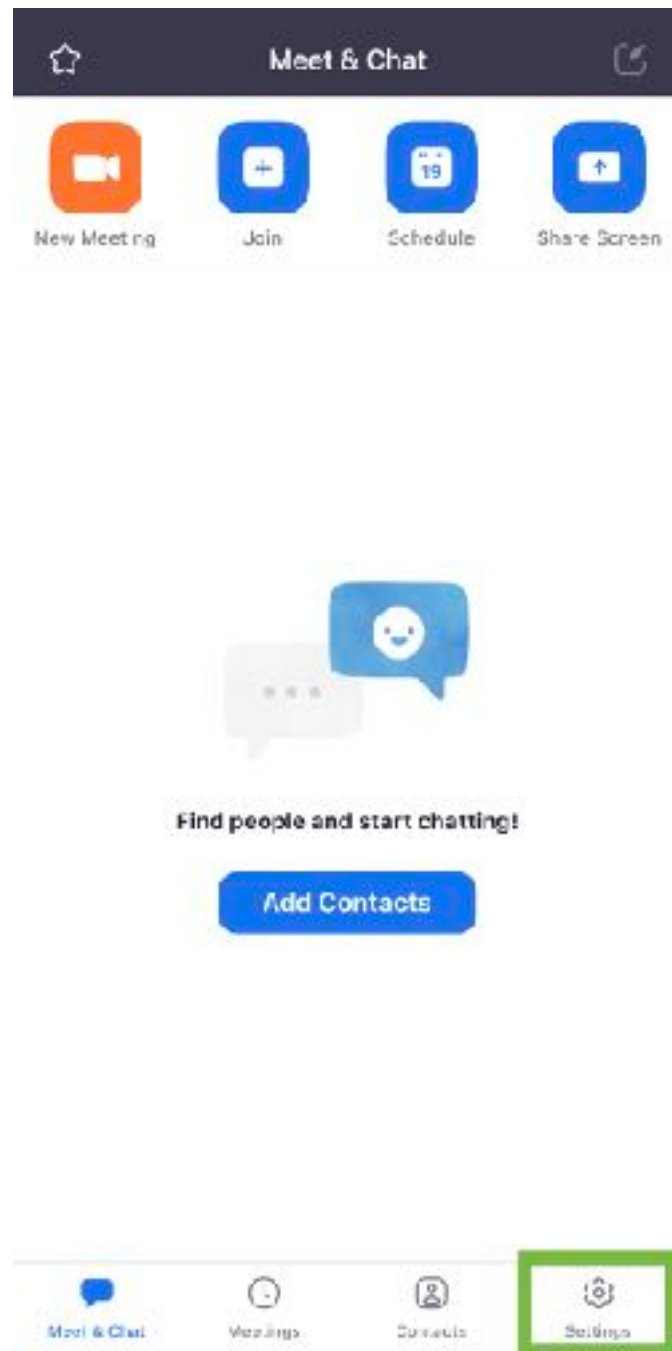


Under 'Suppress background noise' make sure that either Auto or Low are selected otherwise your teacher won't be able to hear you when you play.

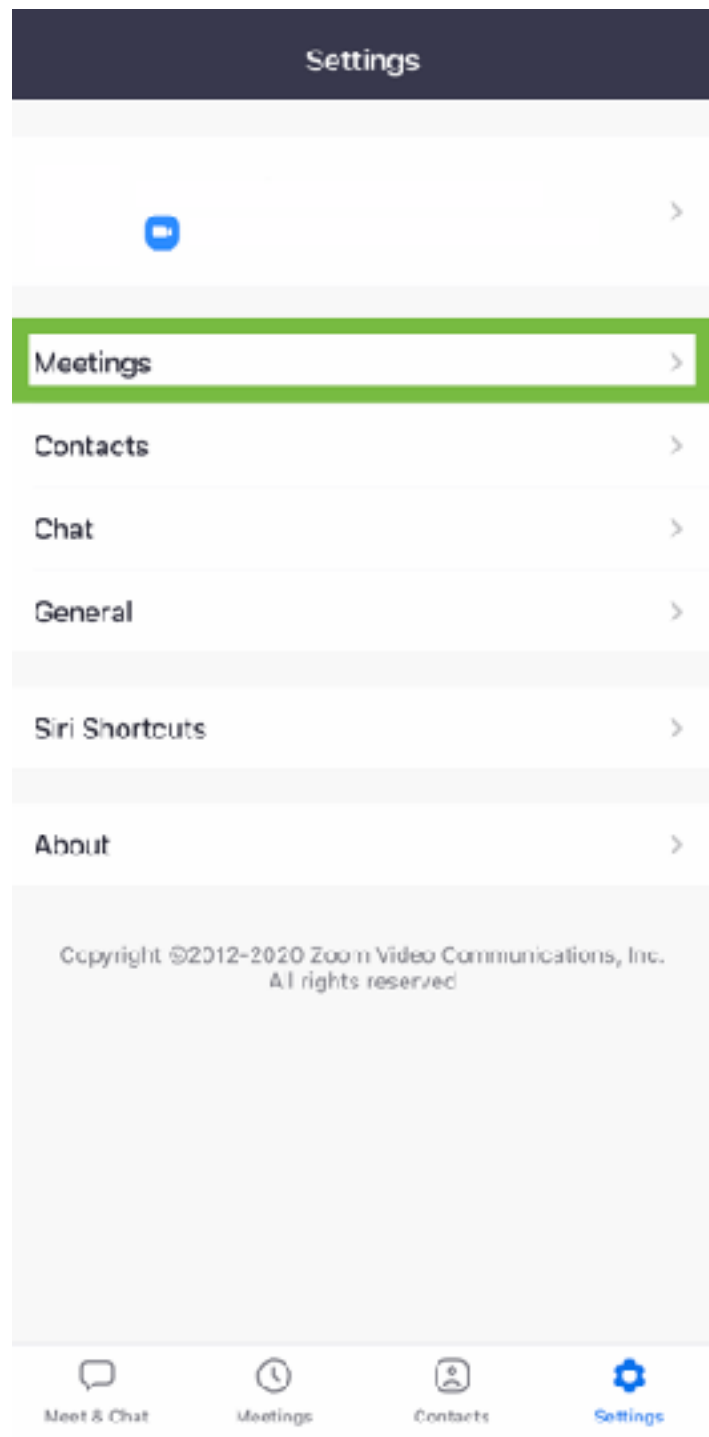


If you are using a phone or tablet (not recommended):

Open the App and click on 'Settings'.



Click on 'Meetings'



Scroll down and turn on 'Use original sound'. This will make it easier for your teacher to hear what you're doing but still won't be as good as if you were to use a laptop.
